Each competition has a different level of category and/or age division (See event website or check with us at the studio for further information)

Scoring

For the majority of competitions each routine will receive up to 100 points based on the following

Technique (most points), Execution, Presentation and Choreography

Some of the other categories include difficulty, showmanship, costume/appearance

Convention Information

Conventions are a fantastic way for students to try out different dance styles, learn new skills, meet friends and continue to grow in their dance techniques. Classes typically start Saturday and finish up Sunday afternoon. Students wanting to perform their solos, duos, or trios at convention must sign up for the full weekend of workshops.

Studio Policies

To participate in competition or attend conventions students must be part of the CCPA dance company. All solo, duo, and trio dances must be pre-approved by Angie or Laura. It is recommended that you are enrolled in a class that is the same genre as your solo, duo or trio. Company dancers attending the competition are expected to perform with all of their group dances.

Travel

Parents/Guardians are responsible for travel arrangements to and from events. For competitions you will need to arrive 1 ½ - 2 hours before your scheduled performance times and stay for awards ceremonies that take place the same day of your performance. For conventions you will need to arrive about ½ hour before the start of the event and plan on picking up at the end. Some conventions allow for parent observers but most do not due to limited space.

Competition and Convention Fees

It is VERY IMPORTANT that all fees are turned in on time. Cash or Check payments are the preferred method of payment, there will be a 5% additional service charge for all credit/debit cards. CCPA will not register you for any event if payment has not been received on time.

Fundraising will all go towards group entry fees, if there is any money left over it will go towards instructor travel fees. Group dances worked on during company time do not have additional choreography fees.

Solo/Duo/Trio- \$230 choreography and lesson fee

Instructor Travel Fees- Instructor travel will be split among the group attending and will help pay for gas, lodging and food. \$20-\$30 depending on the size of the group.

Shoes, Tights, Costume- You will need to purchase the correct matching shoes and tights. Costumes can be purchased on your own or borrowed from the studio's collection. We will try our hardest to use what we have for all of our group dances
