Laura Fambro Cook (Associate Director): Laura is a dancer, choreographer, teacher, and producer who lives in Cody, Wyoming with her husband Rick and two children Trevor and Julia. A Texas native, Laura grew up dancing and baton twirling. She graduated from Angelo State University in San Angelo, Texas where she was a member of the dance team and head of baton twirlers. She was also a company member of the Angelo Dance Theater Jazz Dance Company. Laura earned her baton judging license from the National Baton Twirling Association.

In 1984 Laura started her position at Midland Lee High School, in Midland, Texas where she implemented a dance curriculum and served as founder and director of the Dixie Dolls Dance Team. After moving to Wyoming, Laura began a 13 year long career as professor and director of dance at Northwest College in Powell, Wyoming where she taught jazz,

modern, ballet, and social dance, and served as coach of the cheerleading squad. Laura founded and directed the Dance Electric Dance Team, which grew to be one of the leading dance programs in the region.

With the birth of her daughter, Laura retired from teaching at Northwest College to be a full time mom, and continues her longtime teaching position at the Cody Center for the Performing Arts. Today, she is in her 36th year at the center and serves as assistant director. Since 2005, Laura has been the producer of the Western Design Conference Fashion Show; a runway show that showcases the best of established and up and coming western fashion.
